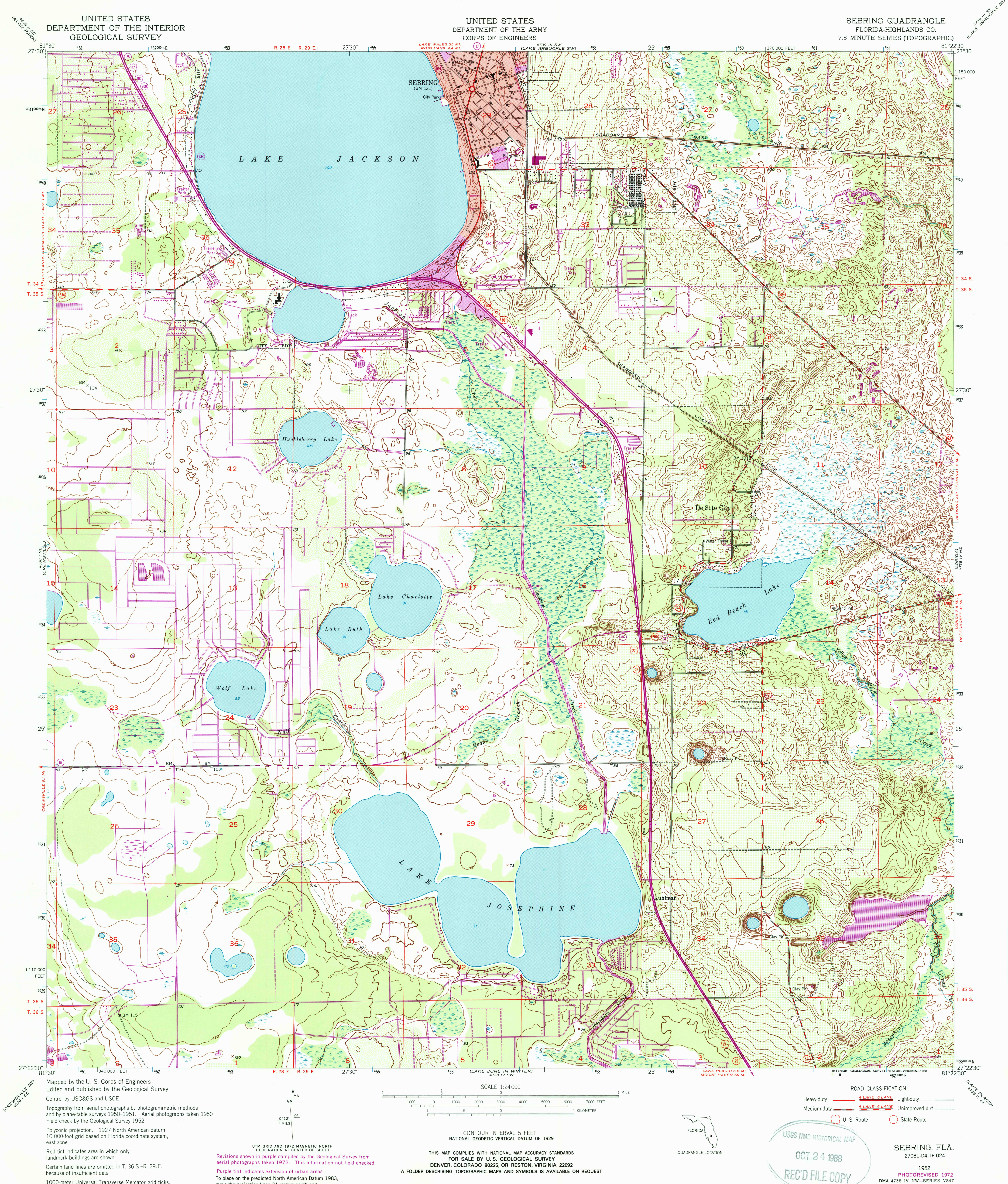

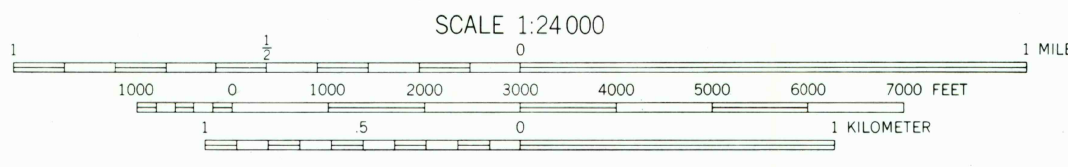

19 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

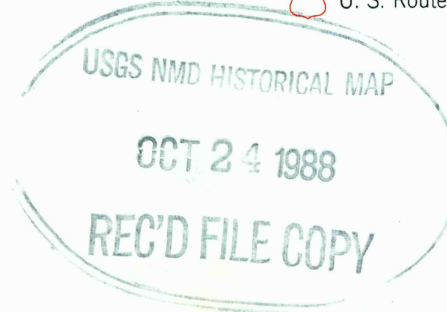


CONTOUR INTERVAL 5 FEET
