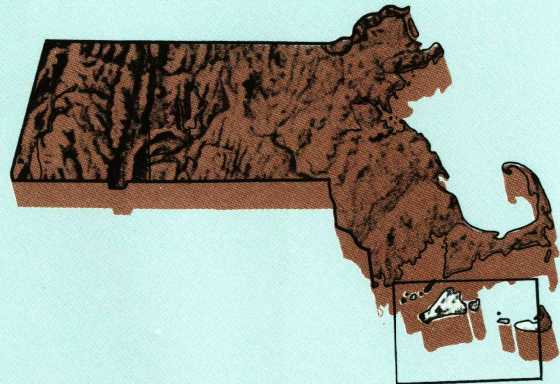


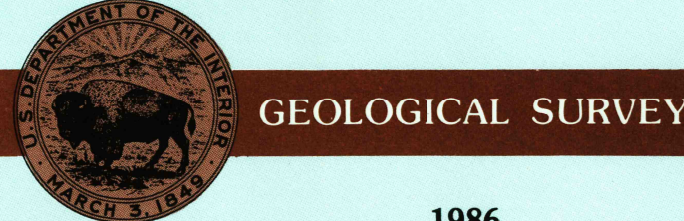
Martha's Vineyard MASSACHUSETTS
