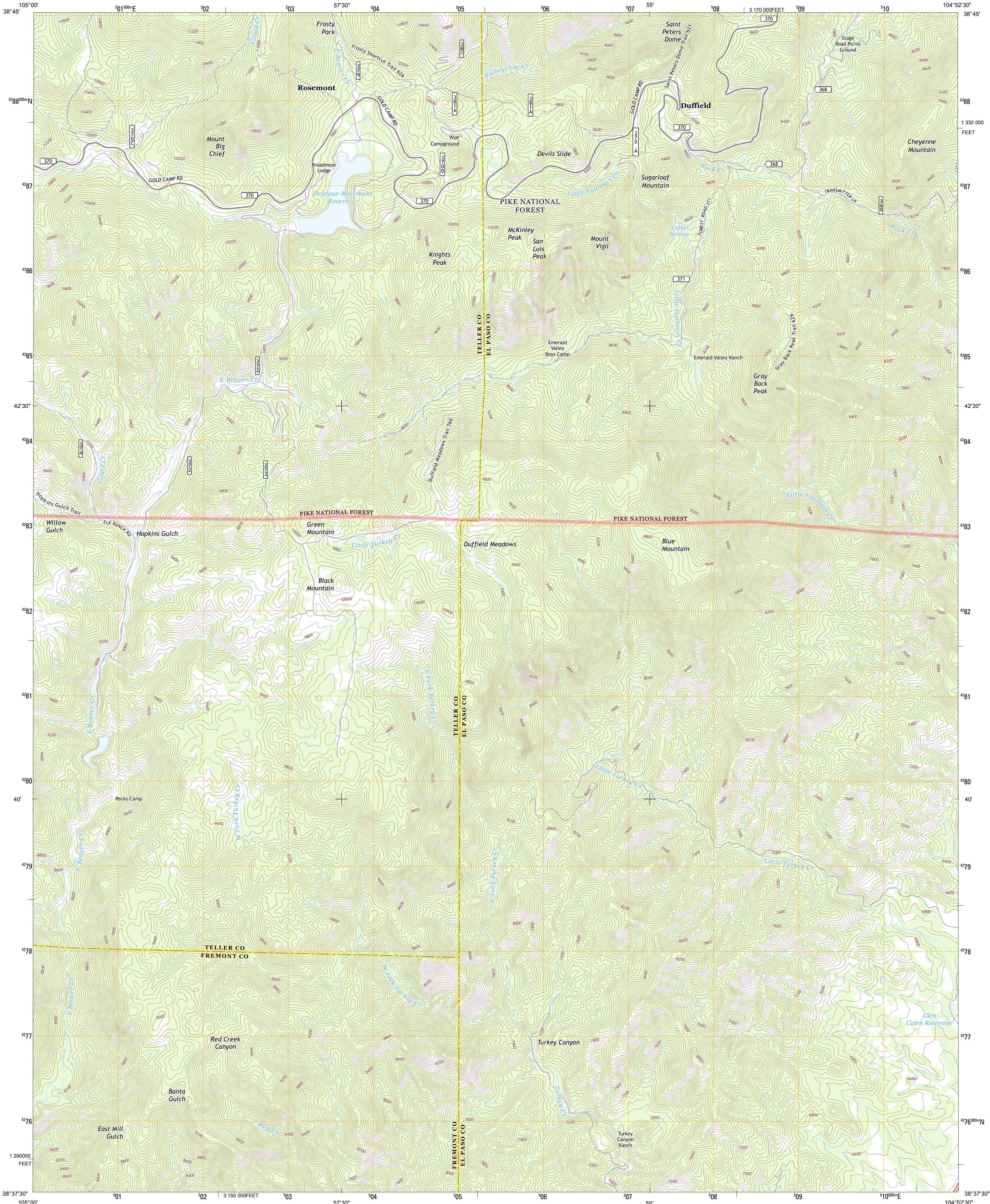

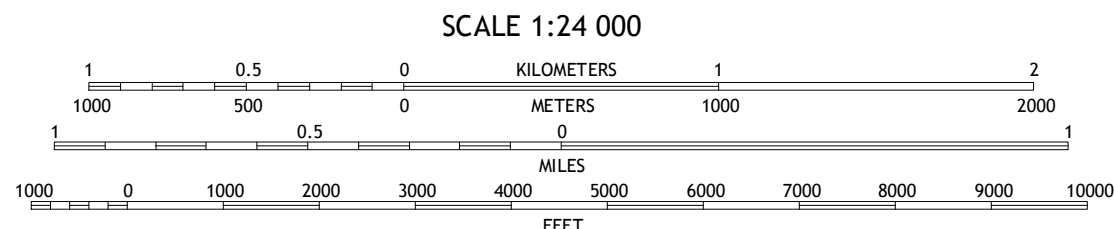
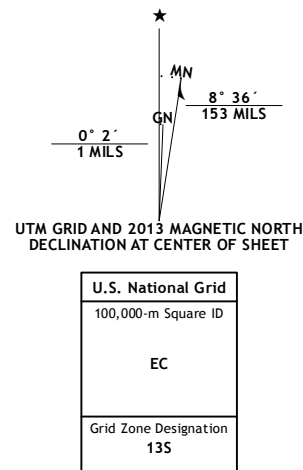


MOUNT BIG CHIEF QUADRANGLE

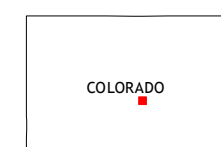
