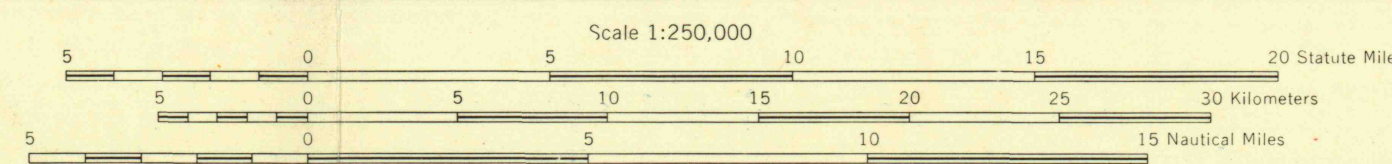

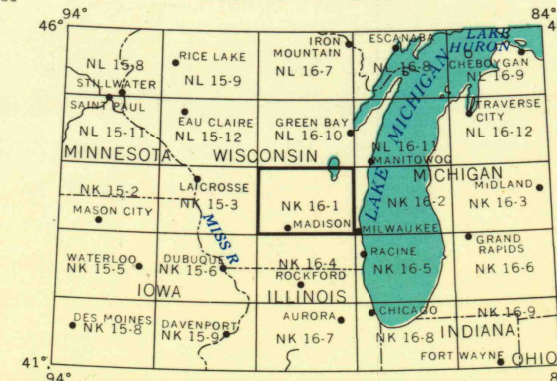


CONTOUR INTERVAL 50 FEET
TRANSVERSE MERCATOR PROJECTION

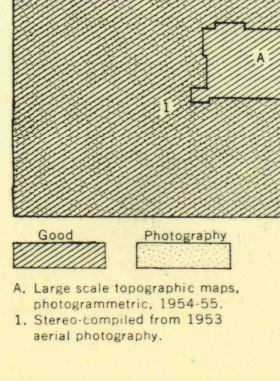

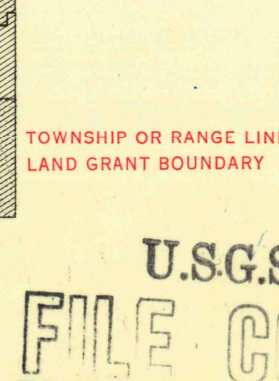
LOCATION DIAGRAM



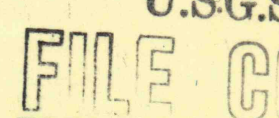
RELIABILITY DIAGRAM



TOWNSHIP OR RANGE LINE



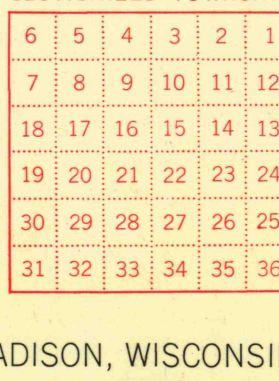
LAND GRANT BOUNDARY
