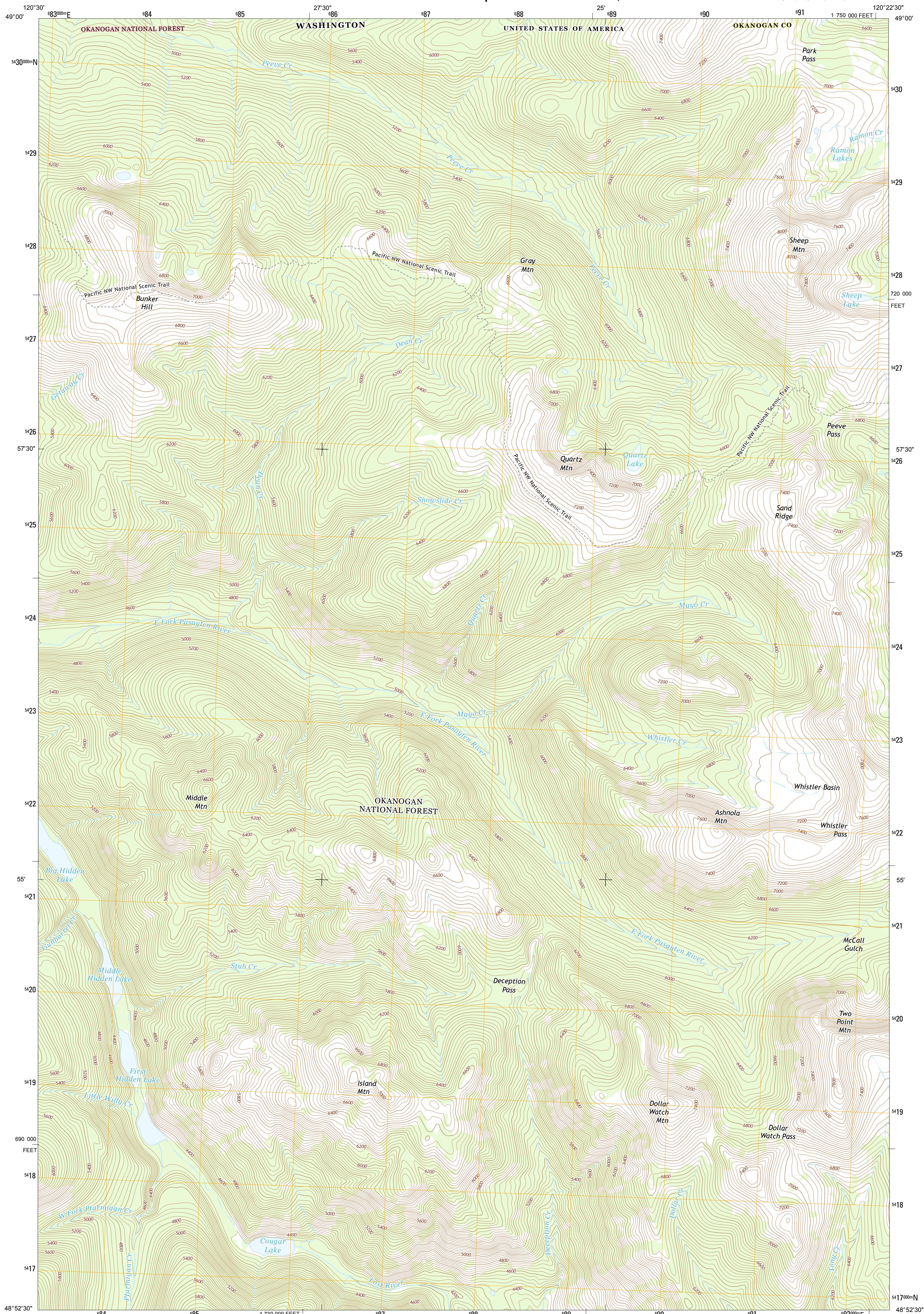
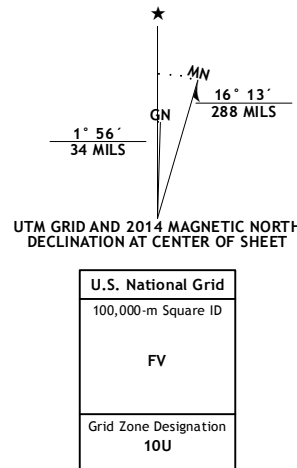

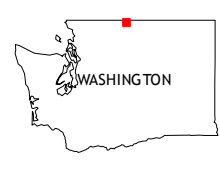

The graphic scale bar is divided into four units: kilometers, meters, miles, and feet. The kilometers scale ranges from 0 to 2, with a major tick at 1. The meters scale ranges from 0 to 2000, with major ticks at 1000 and 2000. The miles scale ranges from 0 to 1, with major ticks at 0.5 and 1. The feet scale ranges from 0 to 10000, with major ticks every 1000 units. 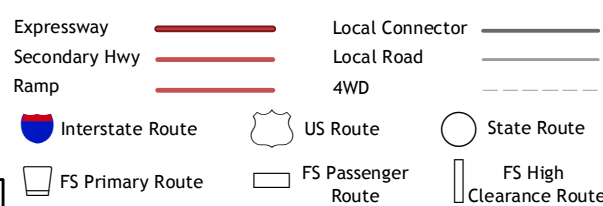
