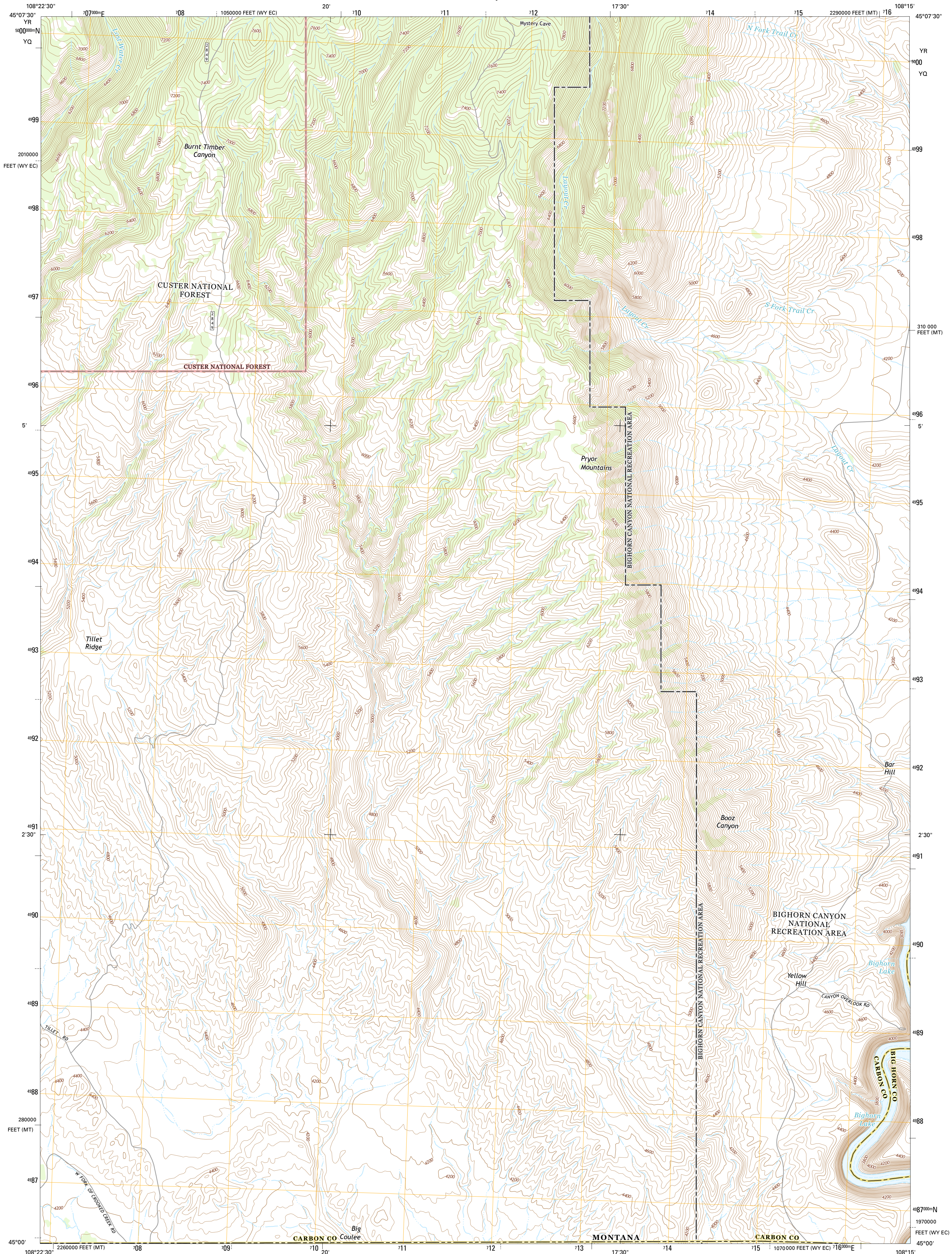

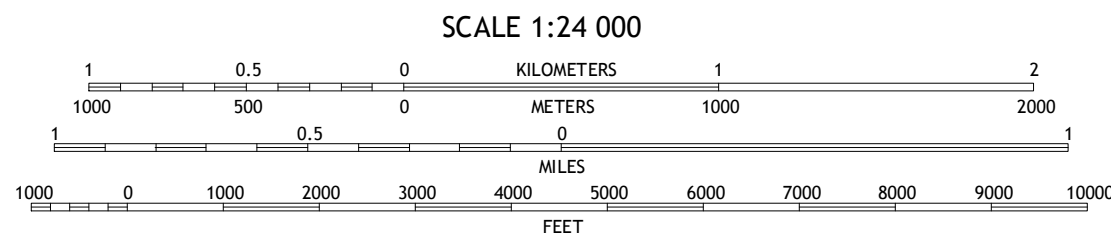
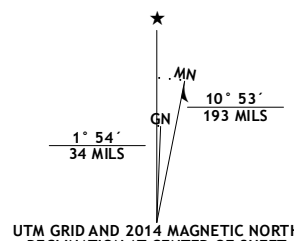
MYSTERY CAVE QUADRANGLE
