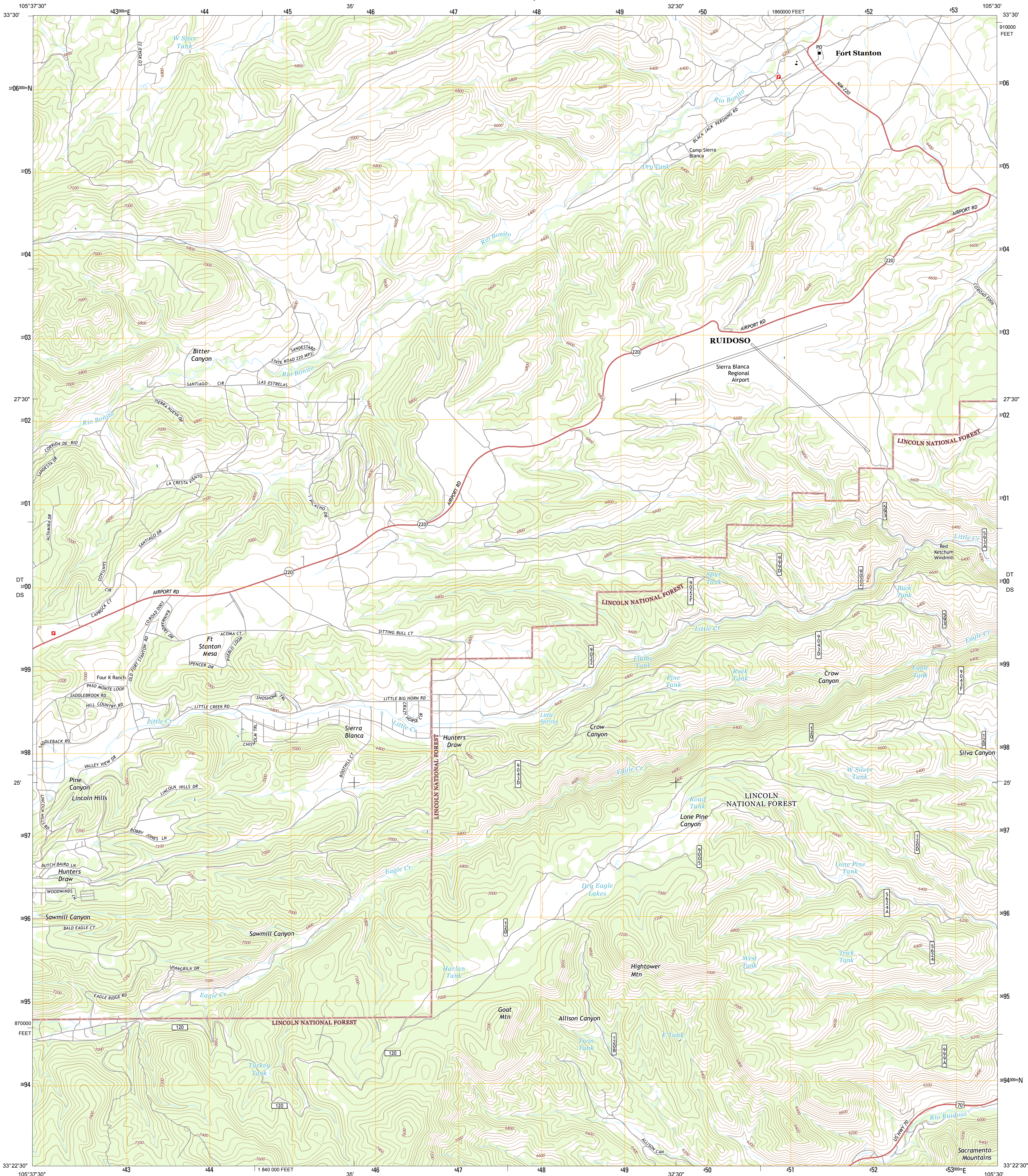

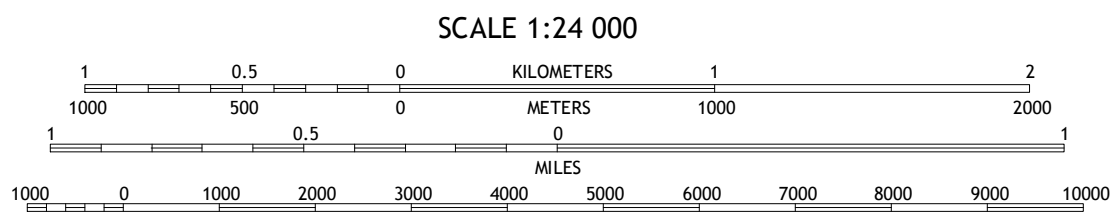


FORT STANTON QUADRANGLE
