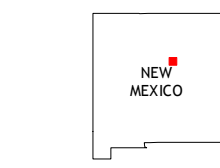
SAN JUAN QUADRANGLE

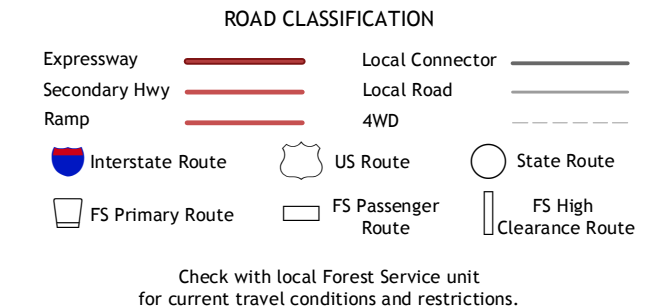
