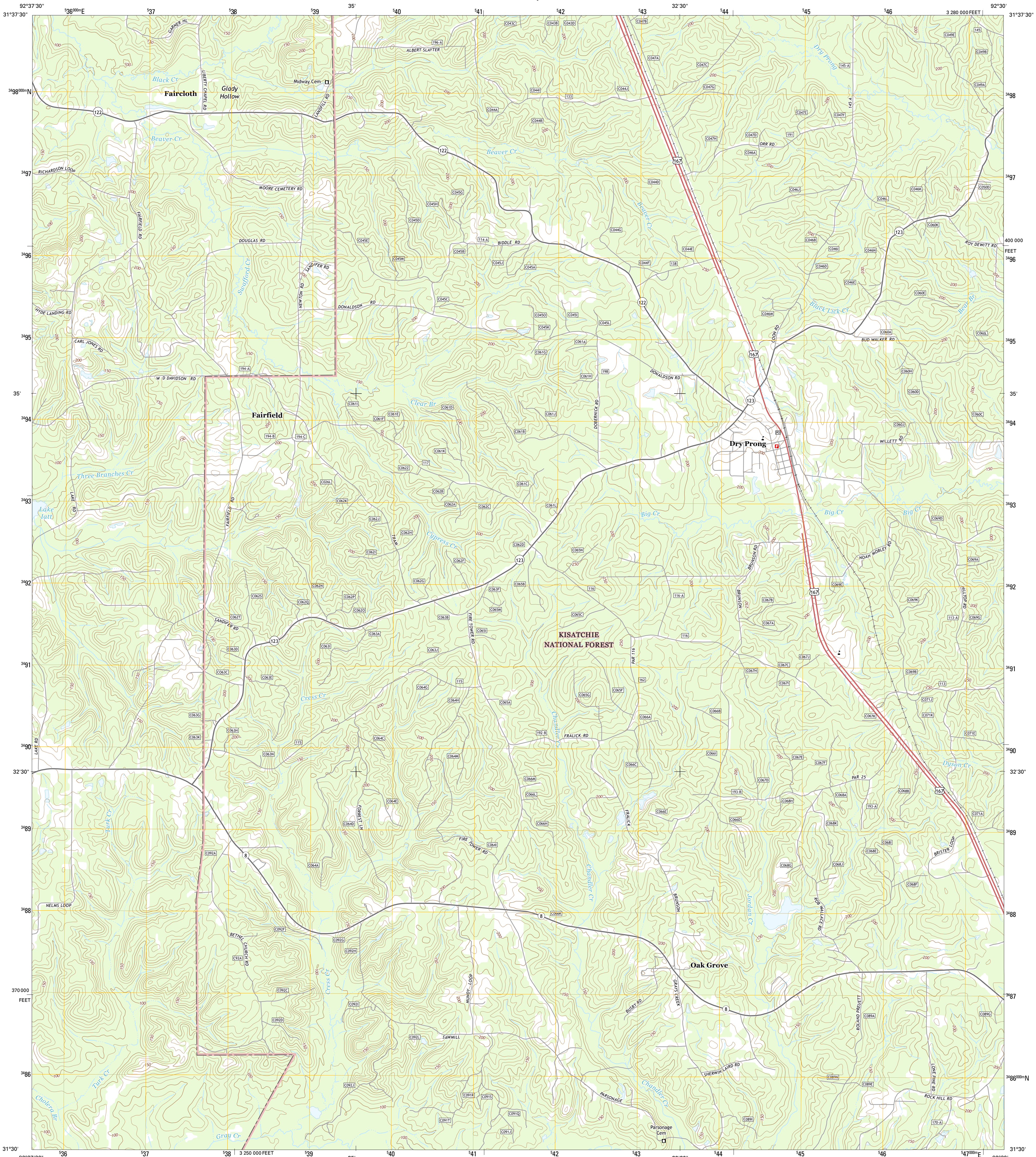

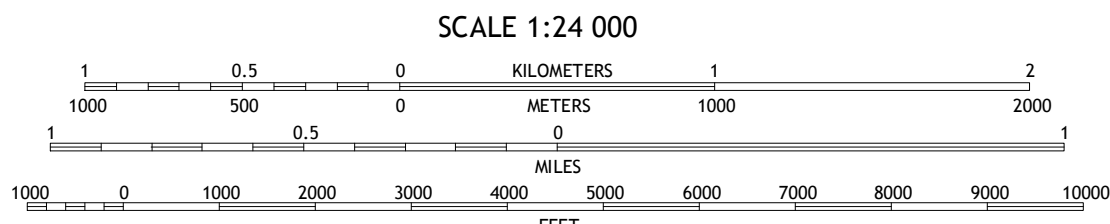


DRY PRONG QUADRANGLE
