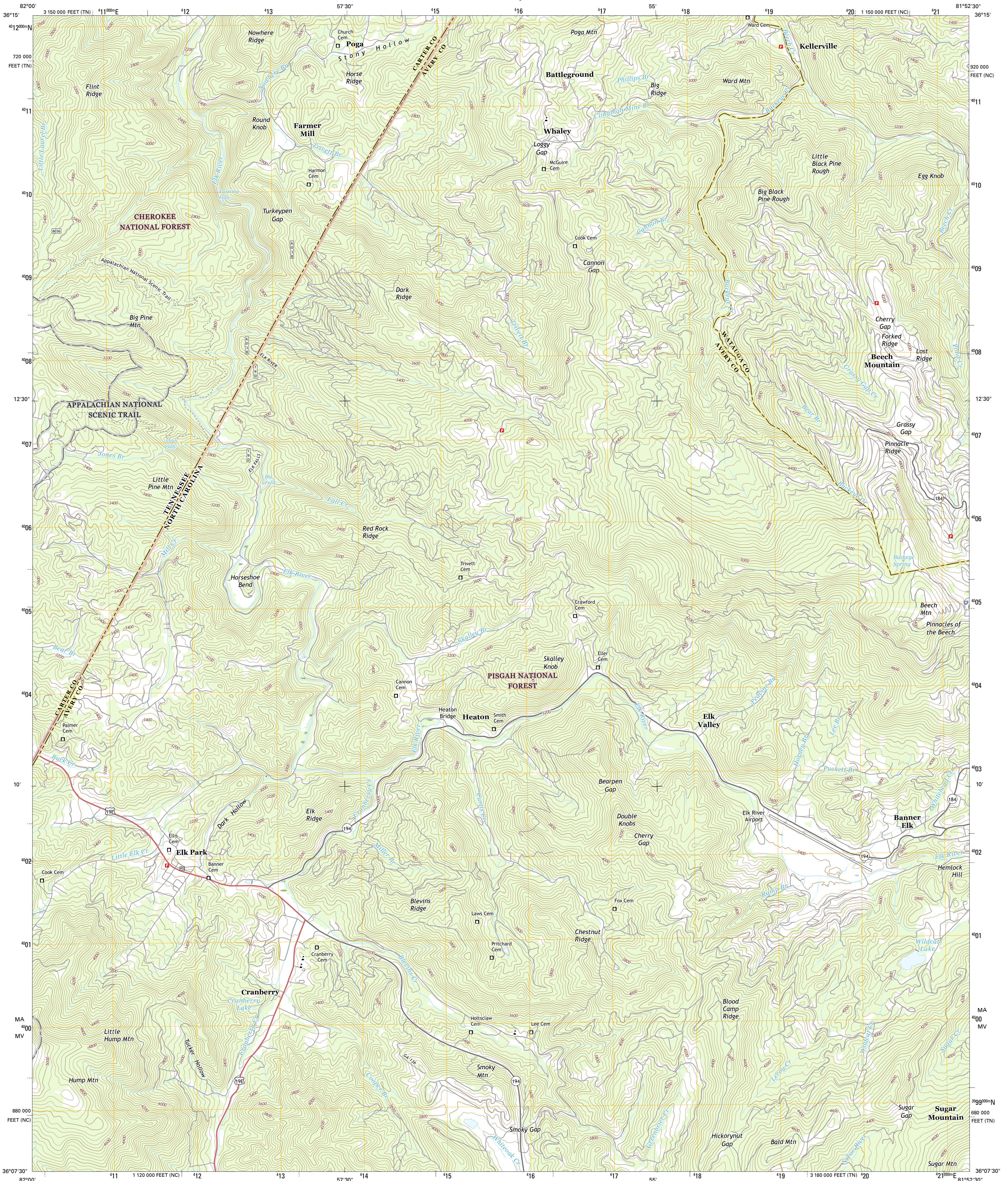

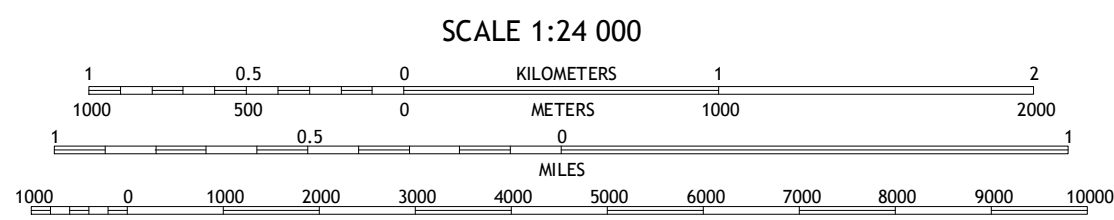
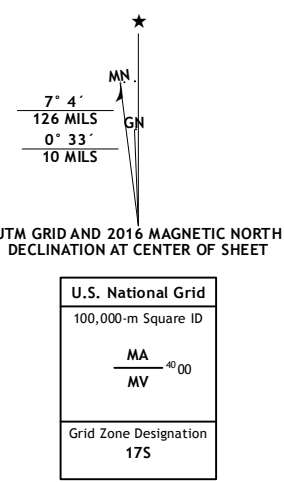
ELK PARK QUADRANGLE
