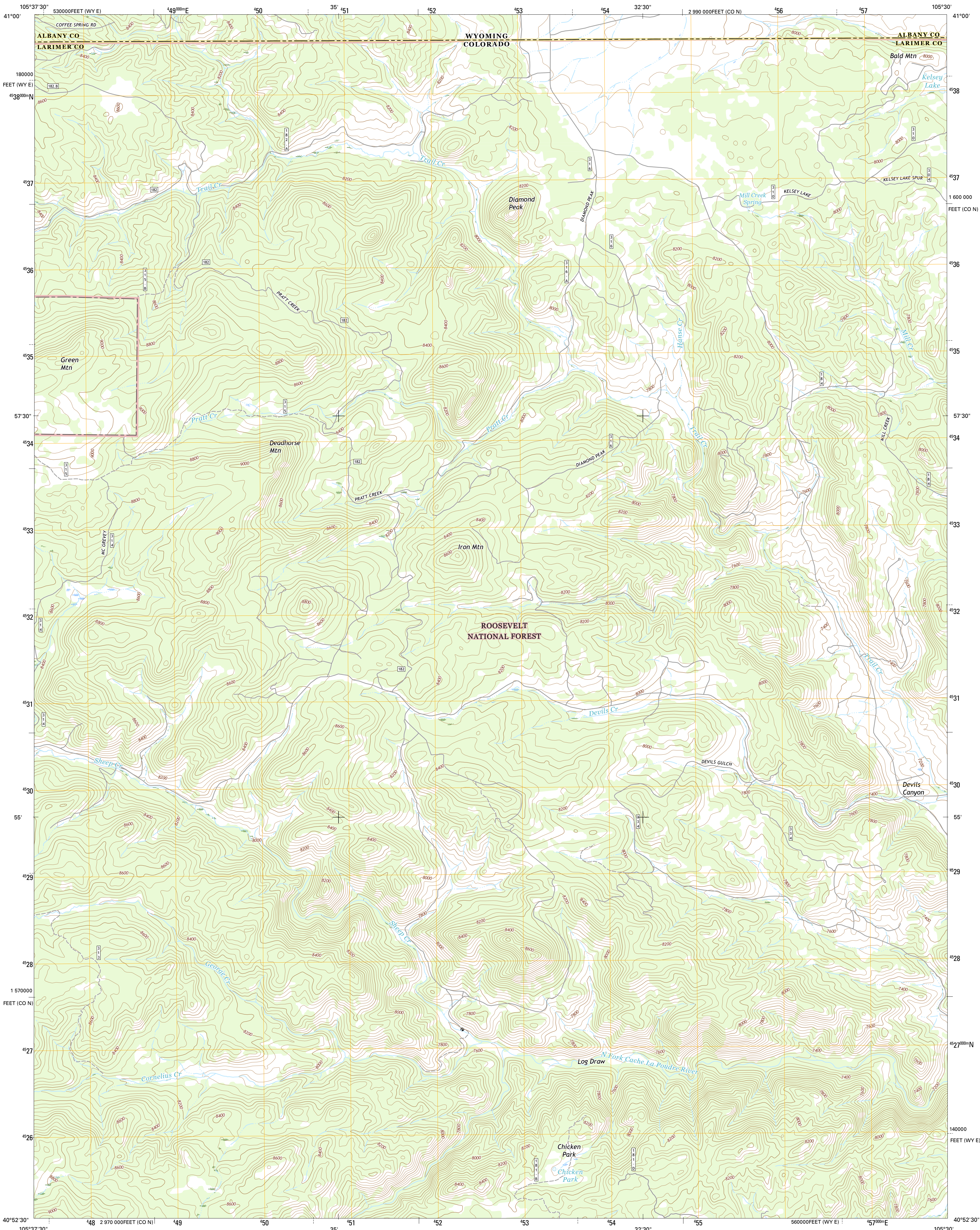

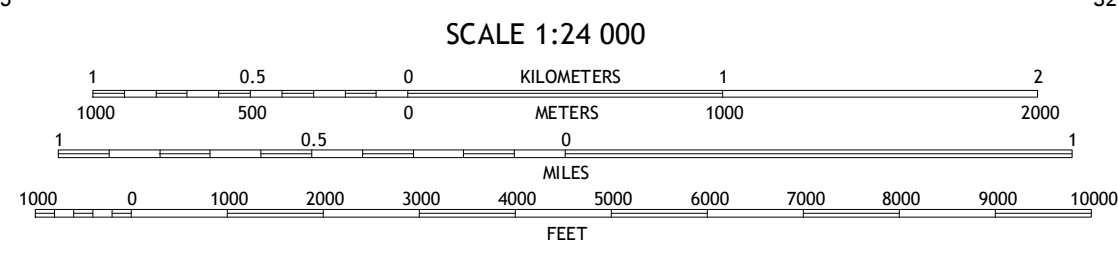
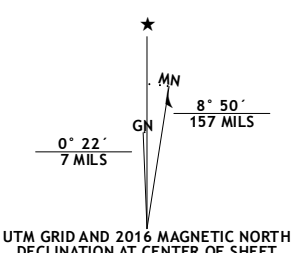
DIAMOND PEAK QUADRANGLE

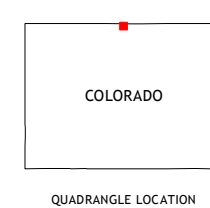
