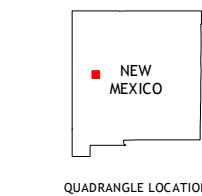
BONINE CANYON QUADRANGLE

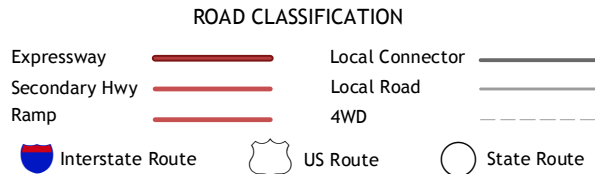
